

# NONVIABLE VACCINE RETURNS

## What **SHOULD NOT** be Returned to McKesson



**NEVER** return the following items to McKesson:

- Syringes that you filled yourself but did not use
- Any used syringes with or without needles attached
- Broken vials
- Any multidose vial from which some doses have already been withdrawn
- IG, HBIG, PPD
- Expired diluents

The items listed above should be disposed of according to usual medical biosafety procedures, and according to your immunization program's procedures.

## What **SHOULD** be Returned to McKesson

**ONLY** return the following items to McKesson:

- Spoiled or expired product in its original vial or pre-filled syringe.
- Unused pre-filled syringes from manufacturers with an NDC printed on them.
- The **ONLY** unused items providers can return to McKesson with a needle are the Novartis Fluvirin pre-filled syringes with staked needles (NDC 66521-0111-01). The needle should be capped and the syringes returned in their original packaging. (**DO NOT return any other needles to McKesson.**)

McKesson can only process federal excise tax (FET) credits for unopened vials and manufacturer pre-filled syringes. Returns of products other than these *are not* eligible for FET credit.

**REMINDER:** Send vaccine returns to McKesson with a completed Vaccine Return and Waste Form.
